

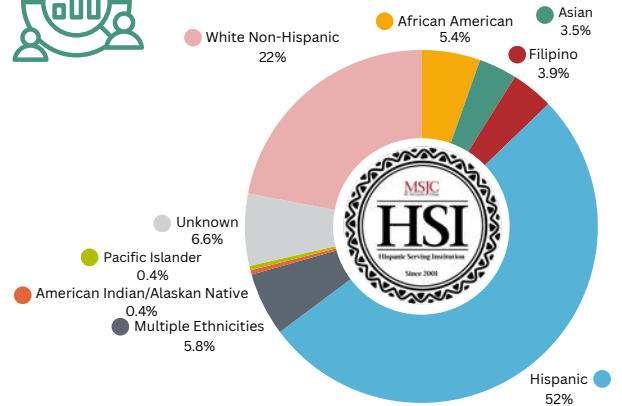


Student Enrollment

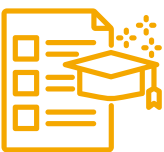
Students Who Transfer to a 4-Year University
